

The Enrollment Process

The application process simply requires completion of a scholar application, which includes basic scholar and family identification information for the purposes of entry into a public random drawing (lottery). The application is available online at rmprep.org

The Lottery

Rocky Mount Prep will admit all scholars who wish to attend the school subject only to approved capacity. Following the open application period each year, applications are counted to determine whether any grade level has received more applications than availability. In the event that this occurs, RMP will hold a public random drawing (lottery) to determine enrollment for the impacted grade level, with the exception of existing scholars, who are guaranteed enrollment in the following school year.

At the conclusion of the public random drawing, all scholars who were not granted admission due to capacity will be placed on a wait list in the order of their draw in the lottery. This wait list will allow scholars the option of enrollment in the case of an opening during the school year. Scholars who apply after the lottery will be added to the wait list in the order in which applications are received. In no circumstance will a wait-list carry over to the following school year.

Enrollment preferences in the case of a public random drawing shall be allowed only for the following:

- Children of RMP school staff
- Siblings of currently enrolled scholars

After Admission

Upon selection for admission as a result of the lottery, the registration process will include the following:

- Enrollment form which contains scholar name, address, and other identifying and demographic information
- Proof of Immunization

- Home Language Survey
- Completion of Emergency Medical Information Form
- Proof of age requirements, e.g. birth certificate
- Academic information from the previous school (if applicable), including transcripts and/or report cards
- Documentation of special learning needs and required accommodations
